3 FOR the purpose of requiring certain local school systems to create certain dining menus; requiring a certain dining menu to include certain information under certain 4  $\mathbf{5}$ circumstances; requiring certain local school systems to post certain information on 6 the local school system's Web site; requiring certain public schools to provide a 7 certain link on the public school's Web site under certain circumstances; requiring 8 certain public schools to send, by regular mail, certain information to parents and 9 guardians under certain circumstances; and generally relating to food transparency in public schools. 10

- SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
