## A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Workers' Compensation – Permanent Partial Disability Compensation –**  
3 **Reversal or Modification of Award**

4 FOR the purpose of applying certain provisions of law relating to the reversal or  
5 modification of an award of permanent partial disability compensation to a reversal  
6 or modification by the Workers' Compensation Commission; clarifying that, for  
7 purposes of a certain provision of law relating to the reversal or modification of an  
8 award of permanent partial disability compensation, the payment of certain new  
9 compensation awarded is subject to a certain monetary credit for compensation  
10 previously awarded and paid; providing for the application of this Act; and generally  
11 relating to the reversal or modification of an award of permanent partial disability  
12 compensation.

18 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,  
19 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

20 **Article – Labor and Employment**

21 9–633.

22 If an award of permanent partial disability compensation is reversed or modified by  
23 **THE COMMISSION OR** a court on appeal, the payment of any new compensation awarded  
24 shall be:

1                   (1)     subject to a **MONETARY** credit for compensation previously awarded  
2 and paid; and

3                   (2)     otherwise made in accordance with this Part IV of this subtitle.

4           SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall be construed to  
5 apply only prospectively and may not be applied or interpreted to have any effect on or  
6 application to any award of compensation before the effective date of this Act.

7           SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect  
8 October 1, 2015.
