A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 Public Health – Dental Services for Adults – Coverage and Access

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1 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the Department of Health 2 and Mental Hygiene shall:

3 (1) in conjunction with the Maryland Health Benefit Exchange and the 4 Maryland Insurance Administration, work with stakeholders to identify short-term and 5 long-term options for expanding access to dental services for adults, including older adults; 6 and

7 (2) on or before December 31, 2015, report its findings to the Senate 8 Finance Committee and House Health and Government Operations Committee, in 9 accordance with § 2–1246 of the State Government Article.

10 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 11 October 1, 2015.
