BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND. 14 15 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows: **Article - General Provisions** 16 17 5-104.18 This title shall be administered and implemented by: 19 EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN SUBSECTIONS (B) AND (C) OF THIS SECTION, (A) 20 THIS TITLE SHALL BE ADMINISTERED AND IMPLEMENTED BY THE ETHICS

- [(1)] (B) [the] THE Joint Ethics Committee, acting as an advisory body [as to the application of], SHALL ADMINISTER AND IMPLEMENT Subtitle 5 of this title AS IT APPLIES to members of the General Assembly [;].
- [(2)] (C) [the Commission on Judicial Disabilities] THE JUDICIAL ETHICS COMMITTEE or another body designated by the Court of Appeals, acting as an advisory body [as to the application of], SHALL ADMINISTER AND IMPLEMENT Subtitles 5 and 6 of this title AS THOSE SUBTITLES APPLY to State officials of the Judicial Branch [; and
- 9 (3) in all other matters, the Ethics Commission].

- 11 (a) A school board shall submit regulations adopted under this part, and amendments to adopted regulations, to the Ethics Commission for review and approval or disapproval.
- 14 (b) If the Ethics Commission does not disapprove a regulation or an amendment 15 to a regulation within 60 days after its submission, the regulation or amendment is deemed 16 to have been approved and becomes effective.
- 17 (c) (1) The Ethics Commission may disapprove a regulation or an amendment 18 to a regulation only if the Ethics Commission finds that the regulation or amendment is 19 not in substantial compliance with this part.
- 20 (2) If the Ethics Commission disapproves a regulation or an amendment, 21 the Ethics Commission shall promptly notify the school board of the action.
- 22 (d) On request of a school board, the Ethics Commission shall advise and assist 23 the school board in preparing regulations that comply with this [title] PART.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2015.
