19 20	SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
21 22	Article – Family Law 5–550.
23	(a) In Part V of this subtitle the following words have the meanings indicated.
24	(b) "Department" means the State Department of Education.

- 1 (d) "Family child care provider" means an individual who cares for children in a registered family child care home or a registered large family child care home.
- 3 5-552.
- 4 (a) Except as otherwise provided in this section, a family child care home or large 5 family child care home may not operate unless it is registered.
- 6 (b) (1) [A] EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN PARAGRAPH (2) OF THIS 7 SUBSECTION, A family child care home is not required to be registered if the child care 8 provider:
- 9 [(1)] (I) is related to each child by blood or marriage;
- 10 **[(2)] (II)** is a friend of each child's parents or legal guardian and the care 11 is provided on an occasional basis; or
- [(3)] (III) has received the care of the child from a child placement agency licensed by the Department of Human Resources or by a local department of social services.
- 14 (2) A FAMILY CHILD CARE HOME THAT PARTICIPATES IN THE 15 MARYLAND CHILD CARE SUBSIDY PROGRAM SHALL:
- 16 (I) BE REGISTERED WITH THE DEPARTMENT; AND
- 17 (II) COMPLY WITH THE REGULATIONS ADOPTED BY THE 18 DEPARTMENT IN ACCORDANCE WITH § 5–551 OF THIS SUBTITLE.
- 19 (c) A person may not advertise a family child care home, large family child care 20 home, or family child care service unless the family child care home or large family child 21 care home is registered under the provisions of this Part V of this subtitle.
- 22 (d) An employee of the Department charged with the investigation and 23 enforcement of child care regulations may serve a civil citation to a person found in violation 24 of this section.

- 26 (a) In this Part XI of this subtitle the following words have the meanings 27 indicated.
- 28 (b) "Family child care provider" means [an individual who participates in the 29 Maryland Child Care Subsidy Program who is:

- 1 (1)] a registered provider, as defined in § 5–550(d) of this subtitle, WHO PARTICIPATES IN THE MARYLAND CHILD CARE SUBSIDY PROGRAM [; or
- 3 (2) exempt from the registration requirements under  $\S$  5–552(b) of this 4 subtitle].
- 5 (c) "Provider organization" means an organization that:
- 6 (1) includes family child care providers; and
- 7 (2) has as one of its purposes the representation of family child care 8 providers in their relations with the State.
- 9 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 10 October 1, 2015.
