2 **Washington County – Board of License Commissioners – Expungement of**  
3 **Violations**

4 FOR the purpose of requiring, in Washington County, violations of the alcoholic beverages  
5 laws of the State to be expunged by the Washington County Board of License  
6 Commissioners after a certain period of time; and generally relating to the  
7 expungement of violations by the Washington County Board of License  
8 Commissioners.

14 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,  
15 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

16 **Article 2B – Alcoholic Beverages**

1           **(B) A VIOLATION OF THIS ARTICLE OR OF ANY REGULATION ADOPTED**  
 2 **UNDER THIS ARTICLE SHALL BE EXPUNGED BY THE BOARD OF LICENSE**  
 3 **COMMISSIONERS AFTER 5 YEARS FROM THE DATE THE VIOLATION OCCURRED.**

4           SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect  
 5 October 1, 2015.
