A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Motor Vehicle Administration – Commercial Driver’s License – Program for**
3 **Veterans and Service Members**
4 **(Troops to Trucks)**

5 FOR the purpose of requiring the Motor Vehicle Administration to establish a program to
6 assist veterans and members of the military transitioning out of military service to
7 obtain a commercial driver’s license and find employment; requiring the
8 Administration, as part of the program, to waive a certain skills test for certain
9 program participants, coordinate with certain persons to provide certain education
10 courses on military bases, and establish a certain process; requiring the
11 Administration to adopt certain regulations; making a conforming change; and
12 generally relating to commercial drivers’ licenses.

23 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
24 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

25 **Article – Transportation**

26 16–807.

1 (b) (1) [An] **EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN § 16-807.1 OF THIS SUBTITLE, AN**
2 individual may not be issued a commercial driver's license until the individual has passed
3 the knowledge and skill tests for driving a commercial motor vehicle which complies with
4 the minimum federal standards established by the federal Commercial Motor Vehicle
5 Safety Act of 1986 (Title XII of Public Law 99-570), and has satisfied all other requirements
6 of that act as well as any other requirements of this title.

7 (2) The tests shall be prescribed and conducted at the direction of the
8 Administration.

9 (3) The Administration shall adopt regulations to waive the skill test
10 required under paragraph (1) of this subsection in a manner consistent with 49 C.F.R. §
11 383.77.

13 (A) **THE ADMINISTRATION SHALL ESTABLISH A PROGRAM TO ASSIST**
14 **VETERANS AND MEMBERS OF THE MILITARY WHO ARE TRANSITIONING OUT OF**
15 **MILITARY SERVICE TO OBTAIN A COMMERCIAL DRIVER'S LICENSE AND FIND**
16 **EMPLOYMENT.**

17 (B) **AS PART OF THE PROGRAM, THE ADMINISTRATION SHALL:**

18 (1) **WAIVE THE SKILLS TEST REQUIRED UNDER § 16-807(B) OF THIS**
19 **SUBTITLE FOR PROGRAM PARTICIPANTS WHO MEET ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA**
20 **ESTABLISHED BY THE ADMINISTRATION, CONSISTENT WITH FEDERAL LAW;**

21 (2) **COORDINATE WITH MILITARY BASES, COMMUNITY COLLEGES**
22 **THAT OFFER COMMERCIAL DRIVER EDUCATION COURSES, THE MARYLAND MOTOR**
23 **TRUCK ASSOCIATION, INC., AND ANY OTHER APPROPRIATE PARTY TO PROVIDE**
24 **COMMERCIAL DRIVER EDUCATION COURSES ON MILITARY BASES; AND**

25 (3) **ESTABLISH A PROCESS TO ASSIST PROGRAM PARTICIPANTS TO**
26 **FIND EMPLOYMENT.**

27 (C) **THE ADMINISTRATION SHALL ADOPT REGULATIONS TO IMPLEMENT**
28 **THE PROVISIONS OF THIS SECTION.**

29 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
30 October 1, 2015.
