A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

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State Board of Education - Next Generation Schools - Established

3 FOR the purpose of requiring certain Next Generation Schools to be operated under the supervision of the State Board of Education; requiring the State Board to submit a 4 5 certain request for proposals (RFP) for a certain number of operators of Next 6 Generation Schools on or before a certain date; requiring certain operators to meet 7 certain qualifications; requiring a certain RFP to include certain information; 8 authorizing certain operators to request certain waivers subject to certain 9 limitations; requiring certain teachers and personnel to be paid a certain salary and 10 authorizing them to form certain bargaining units for certain purposes; requiring the 11 State Board to determine the funding of a Next Generation School; authorizing the 12 State Board to include certain students in certain enrollment counts for certain 13 purposes under certain circumstances; requiring certain county boards of education 14 to pay certain amounts of money to the State Department of Education under certain 15 circumstances; requiring certain county governing bodies to include certain students 16 in certain calculations under certain circumstances; requiring the Department to 17 disburse certain funds to Next Generation Schools under certain circumstances; 18 establishing a certain fund for a certain purpose; requiring the Department to 19 administer the fund; providing for the composition of the fund; specifying the uses of 20 the fund; requiring the State Treasurer to invest the money of the fund in a certain 21 manner; defining certain terms; and generally relating to the establishment of Next 22 Generation Schools in the State.
