A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Statewide Information Technology Master Plan – Security Policy**

3 FOR the purpose of requiring the statewide information technology master plan developed
4 by the Secretary of Information Technology to include a certain policy requiring
5 certain vendors to establish that an information technology product or piece of
6 equipment is safe from embedded security threats; and generally relating to the
7 statewide information technology master plan.

13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
14 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

15 **Article – State Finance and Procurement**

16 3A–304.

17 (A) The Secretary shall develop a statewide information technology master plan.

18 (B) **THE STATEWIDE INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY MASTER PLAN**
19 **DEVELOPED UNDER SUBSECTION (A) OF THIS SECTION SHALL INCLUDE A POLICY**
20 **THAT:**

21 (1) **REQUIRES A VENDOR SELLING AN INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY**
22 **PRODUCT OR A PIECE OF EQUIPMENT TO A UNIT OF STATE GOVERNMENT TO**

EXPLANATION: CAPITALS INDICATE MATTER ADDED TO EXISTING LAW.

1 ESTABLISH THAT THE PRODUCT OR PIECE OF EQUIPMENT IS SAFE FROM EMBEDDED
2 SECURITY THREATS; AND

3 (2) SETS OUT THE STEPS THAT SHALL BE TAKEN TO ESTABLISH THAT
4 THE PRODUCT OR PIECE OF EQUIPMENT IS SAFE FROM EMBEDDED SECURITY
5 THREATS.

6 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
7 October 1, 2015.
