bridge or other appropriate structure to the recipient's spouse, child, or other relative
whose life was lost in combat; and generally relating to State highways.

18 THE ADMINISTRATION SHALL ESTABLISH A PROCESS BY WHICH A MEMBER OF 19 THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY MAY REQUEST, ON BEHALF OF A RECIPIENT OF THE U.S. 20 DEPARTMENT OF DEFENSE GOLD STAR FOR SURVIVING SPOUSES, PARENTS, AND 21 NEXT OF KIN OF MEMBERS OF THE ARMED FORCES WHO LOST THEIR LIVES IN 22 COMBAT, THAT THE ADMINISTRATION DEDICATE A BRIDGE OR ANOTHER 23 APPROPRIATE STRUCTURE UNDER THE JURISDICTION OF THE ADMINISTRATION TO
