BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, 13 14 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows: Article - Natural Resources 15 16 5-212.17 (g) (1) Subject to paragraph (3) of this subsection, the Fund may be used only 18 for: 19 (i) 1. Purchasing and managing in the name of the State lands 20 suitable for forest culture, reserves, watershed protection, State parks, scenic preserves, 21historic monuments, parkways, and State recreational reserves; and 22 2. Helping to offset the costs to the Forest and Park Service

for developing and implementing a forest health emergency contingency program under §

3 4 5	1. If the State forest or park reserve comprises less than 10% of the total land area of the county, a sum equal to 15% of the revenue derived from the State forest or park reserve located in that county; and
6 7 8	2. If the State forest or park reserve comprises 10% or more of the total land area of the county, a sum equal to 25% of the revenue derived from the State forest or park reserve located in that county; and
9 10	(iii) Administrative costs calculated in accordance with $\S 1-103(b)(2)$ of this article.
11 12	(2) For fiscal years 2012 and 2013 only, the payments under paragraph (1)(ii) of this subsection shall be based only on the revenue derived from sales of timber.
13 14 15	(3) From revenues described in subsection (f) of this section that are attributable to Maryland Park Service operations, the Governor shall include in the State budget an appropriation for the Maryland Park Service equal to:
16	(i) At least 60% of the revenues, for fiscal year 2016;
17	(ii) At least 80% of the revenues, for fiscal year 2017; and
18 19	(iii) 100% of the revenues, for fiscal year 2018 and each fiscal year thereafter.
20 21 22	SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That it is the intent of the General Assembly in enacting this Act to ratify the amendments to § 5–212(g) of the Natura Resources Article, as enacted by Chapter 464 of the Acts of the General Assembly of 2014.
23 24	SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 2015 .
