1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Baltimore City – Alcoholic Beverages – Penalties for Sales to Underage Persons**

3 FOR the purpose of altering the maximum fine that the Baltimore City Board of License
4 Commissioners may impose for a first offense of selling alcoholic beverages to a
5 person under a certain age; and generally relating to penalties for sales of alcoholic
6 beverages to persons under a certain age in Baltimore City.

17 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
18 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

19 **Article 2B – Alcoholic Beverages**

2 (a) (1) A licensee licensed under this article, or any employee of the licensee,
3 may not sell or furnish any alcoholic beverages at any time:

4 (i) To a person under 21 years of age for the underage person's own
5 use or for the use of any other person; or

6 (ii) To any person who, at the time of the sale, or delivery, is visibly
7 under the influence of any alcoholic beverage.

9 (d) (1) For any violation that is cause for suspension under the alcoholic
10 beverage laws affecting Baltimore City, the Baltimore City Board of License
11 Commissioners may:

12 [(1)] (I) [For] **EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN PARAGRAPH (2) OF THIS**
13 **SUBSECTION, FOR** a first offense, impose a fine of not more than \$500 or suspend the
14 license or both; or

15 [(2)] (II) For any subsequent offense, impose a fine of not more than
16 \$3,000 or suspend the license or both.

17 (2) **FOR A FIRST OFFENSE OF SELLING ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES TO A**
18 **PERSON UNDER 21 YEARS OF AGE, THE BOARD MAY IMPOSE A FINE OF NOT MORE**
19 **THAN \$1,000 OR SUSPEND THE LICENSE OR BOTH.**

20 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
21 October 1, 2015.
