1 (f) A licensing agency shall publish notice of the issuance of a statement of need 2 in the Maryland Register.

3 (g) A licensing agency may not delegate its authority to issue a statement of need.

4 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act is an emergency 5 measure, is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health or safety, has 6 been passed by a yea and nay vote supported by three-fifths of all the members elected to 7 each of the two Houses of the General Assembly, and shall take effect from the date it is 8 enacted.
