Chapter 249

(House Bill 463)

AN ACT concerning

State Board of Morticians and Funeral Directors – Funeral Establishment Licenses – Ownership and Operation Requirements

FOR the purpose of altering the criteria to be used by the State Board of Morticians and Funeral Directors when issuing a funeral establishment license so as to require that the funeral establishment be owned and operated in accordance with certain provisions of law by a certain individual or, <u>a certain</u> group of individuals, <u>or a holder</u> <u>of a certain license</u> or operated in accordance with certain provisions of law by a holder of a certain license; and generally relating to the State Board of Morticians and Funeral Directors, funeral establishment licenses, and ownership and operation requirements.

BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,

Article – Health Occupations Section 7–310(c) Annotated Code of Maryland (2014 Replacement Volume)

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article – Health Occupations

7 - 310.

(c) The Board shall issue a funeral establishment license to a funeral establishment that:

- (1) Has complied with all applicable State and local laws; and
- (2) Will be [owned]:

(I) OWNED and operated in accordance with this title by [at least one] AN INDIVIDUAL WHO IS OR A GROUP OF INDIVIDUALS IN WHICH EACH INDIVIDUAL IS:

- [(i)] **1.** [Licensed] **A** LICENSED mortician;
- [(ii)] 2. [Licensed] A LICENSED funeral director; <u>OR</u>

[(iii)] **3.** [Holder] **A** HOLDER of a surviving spouse license; **OR**

[(iv)] 4. [Holder] A HOLDER of a corporation license; or

(II) OWNED AND OPERATED IN ACCORDANCE WITH THIS TITLE BY A HOLDER OF A CORPORATION LICENSE; OR

[(v)] (III) [Holder] OPERATED IN ACCORDANCE WITH THIS TITLE BY A HOLDER of an executor license.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2015.
