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## 10. Description and Purpose of Grantee Organization (Limit Length to Visible area)

The Frostburg Museum Association is an all- volunteer organization, founded in 1977. The Association is a 501(c)3 non-profit. The Association is managed by a Board of Directors with 12 - 16 members. The organization is funded through memberships, donations, and support from the City of Frostburg. The mission of the Frostburg Museum is to acquire, document, catalogue, preserve, restore and display memorabilia, artifacts and other items related to the history of Frostburg, Maryland, its citizens and its environs, and to provide access and information to those involved in research and study of this area. The Museum houses over 10,000 artifacts, documents, and photographs related to the history of Frostburg.

## 11. Description and Purpose of Project (Limit Length to Visible area)

The Frostburg Museum has the opportunity to relocate to the former St. Michael's School building on Main Street in Frostburg. The current home of the Museum is located in a neighborhood, not near any major road and hard for visitors to find. The current building is in need of major repairs.

St. Michael's Church has agreed to sell the school building to the Museum Association for \$1.00. The new location will allow the Museum to increase visibility, the number of visitors, and will help provide a viable tourist opportunity for visitors to Frostburg. This project will also insure the protection of a historic building in the heart of Frostburg's Historic District through reuse. The relocation of the Museum to Main Street (the National Road, Rt. 40) will contribute to the revitalization of the historic business district. The Western Maryland Scenic Rail Road delivers 40,000 visitors to Frostburg each year and these tourists would be within walking distance to new Museum location. In order for the Museum to occupy the building and be open to the public, it is necessary to make repairs and renovate to satisfy fire and ADA code requirement, estimated to total cost \$2.2 million. State funds will be used for planning, building repairs and improvements to make the building safe and accessible to the public, and usable as a museum.
