### 1 AN ACT concerning

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# Motor Vehicles - Special Registration Plates - Confederate Battle Flag

- 3 FOR the purpose of prohibiting the Motor Vehicle Administration from transferring to 4 another vehicle a special registration plate that displays an emblem or a logo that 5 depicts the Confederate battle flag; prohibiting the Administration from authorizing 6 the display of an emblem or a logo that depicts the Confederate battle flag on special 7 registration plates or a special registration plate; prohibiting the Administration 8 from renewing the registration of a motor vehicle that displays an emblem or a logo 9 that depicts the Confederate battle flag on its special registration plates or plate 10 until the special registration plates or plate is returned to the Administration in 11 exchange for substitute registration plates; and generally relating to the display on 12 special registration plates of emblems or logos that depict the Confederate battle 13 flag.

- 19 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
- 20 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

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## **Article – Transportation**

2 13-502.1.

- (a) [The] EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN SUBSECTION (C) OF THIS SECTION, THE former registered owner of a transferred vehicle may have its plates and registration number transferred to another vehicle in the same classification by applying to the Administration and paying a transfer fee established by the Administration.
- 7 (b) (1) If the vehicle to which the transfer is made is one for which the 8 registration fee is higher than that required for the former vehicle, the owner shall pay, in 9 addition to the transfer fee, the difference between the registration fee paid for the former vehicle and the registration fee otherwise required for the vehicle to which the transfer is 11 made.
- 12 (2) If the vehicle to which the transfer is made is one for which the 13 registration fee is lower than that required for the former vehicle, the Administration need 14 not make any refunds of the difference.
- 15 (C) THE ADMINISTRATION MAY NOT TRANSFER TO ANOTHER VEHICLE 16 SPECIAL REGISTRATION PLATES OR A SPECIAL REGISTRATION PLATE ISSUED 17 UNDER § 13–619 OF THIS TITLE THAT DISPLAYS AN EMBLEM OR A LOGO THAT 18 DEPICTS THE CONFEDERATE BATTLE FLAG.

- 20 (a) The owner of a motor vehicle, or a lessee of the vehicle under a lease not intended as security, or a director, officer, employee, or partner of a business entity that 22 owns the vehicle who is a member or, subject to subsection (c)(3) of this section, the surviving spouse of a member, of an organization considered eligible by the Administration 24 may apply to the Administration for the assignment of a special registration number if the vehicle is included in one of the following classes:
- 26 (1) A Class A (passenger) vehicle;
- 27 (2) A Class E (truck) vehicle with a manufacturer's rated capacity of one 28 ton or less; or
- 29 (3) A Class M (multipurpose) vehicle.
- 30 (b) (1) In this subsection, "motorcyclist organization" means a motorcyclist 31 organization, institution, association, society, or corporation that:
- 32 (i) Is exempt from taxation under § 501(c)(7) of the Internal 33 Revenue Code; and

3 4 5	(2) The owner of a Class D (motorcycle) vehicle who is a member of a motorcyclist organization may apply to the Administration for the assignment of a special registration number for the vehicle.

19 20 21	(d) The Administration shall adopt regulations not inconsistent with the Maryland Vehicle Law to govern the issuance of special registration plates to members of nonprofit organizations under this section.										
22 23 24 25	(e) (1) In addition to the annual registration fee otherwise required under this title, an owner of a vehicle assigned a special registration under this section shall pay a fee determined by the Administration each time new registration plates are issued for the vehicle.										
26	(2) The fee:										
27 28	(i) May not exceed the amount required to enable the Administration to recover its costs under this section;										
29 30	(ii) Shall be retained by the Administration for the purpose of recovering its cost under this section; and

REGISTRATION PLATE.

1 The additional fee required under subsection (e) of this section is not required 2 for special registration of a vehicle that is exempt under § 13–903 of this title, or a vehicle 3 with a special registration plate recognizing: The Maryland National Guard; or 4 (1) 5 (2)A volunteer fire department, volunteer rescue squad, or volunteer 6 ambulance company in this State. 7 The special registration plates or plate issued under this section may (1) (g) 8 consist of: 9 (i) Any combination of letters, numerals, or both; and 1. 10 2. The name, initials, or abbreviation of the name of the 11 organization; or 12(ii) 1. Any combination of letters, numerals, or both; 13 2.
