2 **Somerset County – Sheriff – Salary**

3 FOR the purpose of altering the salary of the Sheriff of Somerset County; providing for the
4 application of this Act; and generally relating to the salary of the Sheriff of Somerset
5 County.

11 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
12 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

13 **Article – Courts and Judicial Proceedings**

14 2–309.

15 (u) (1) (i) The Sheriff of Somerset County shall receive a salary of not less
16 than ~~[\$60,000]~~ **\$75,000** and no expense allowance.

17 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That, pursuant to Article III, § 35
18 of the Maryland Constitution, this Act may not be construed to extend or apply to the salary
19 or compensation of the Sheriff of Somerset County while serving in a term of office
