- SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

HOUSE BILL 169 (a) (1)Except as provided in paragraphs (2), (3), (4), (6), (7), (8), and (9) of this subsection, a person may not hunt any game bird or mammal on Sundays. (2)The following persons may hunt the specified game birds and mammals on Sundays: (i) A person using State certified raptors to hunt game birds or mammals during open season; An unarmed person participating in an organized fox chase to (ii) chase foxes; Provided that the provisions of § 10–906(b)(3) of this title are (iii) met, a person: 1. Using a regulated shooting ground under § 10–906 of this title to hunt the following pen-reared game birds: A. Pheasants: B. Bobwhite quail; C. Chukar partridge; D. Hungarian partridge; E. Tower released flighted mallard ducks; and F. Turkey on a regulated shooting ground that was permitted to release turkey before September 1, 1992; and 2.Having the written permission of the owner of the land or other person designated by the owner of the land, if the land is owned or leased by a person other than the person hunting on Sundays;

23Subject to the provisions of § 10–411 of this subtitle, in Calvert, (iv) 24Caroline, Carroll, Charles, Dorchester, Harford, Queen Anne's, St. Mary's, Somerset, Talbot, Wicomico, and Worcester counties, a person hunting deer on private property with 25a bow and arrow or crossbow during open season on the last three Sundays in October and 2627the second Sunday in November;

28In Calvert County, Caroline County, CARROLL COUNTY, (v)29Charles County, Dorchester County, and St. Mary's County, a person hunting turkey on 30 private property on any Sunday during the spring turkey hunting season; and

1 (vi) In Dorchester County, a person hunting turkey on public land 2 that is designated for hunting by the Department on any Sunday during the spring turkey 3 hunting season.

4 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act is an emergency 5 measure, is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health or safety, has 6 been passed by a yea and nay vote supported by three—fifths of all the members elected to 7 each of the two Houses of the General Assembly, and shall take effect from the date it is 8 enacted.
