2 **Baltimore City – Abandoned Property – Tax Sales – Ground Rent**

3 FOR the purpose of repealing a limitation on selling the whole fee simple interest in certain
4 property in Baltimore City when the property is subject to a ground rent or certain
5 lease; and generally relating to the tax sales of property.

11 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
12 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

13 **Article – Tax – Property**

14 14–816.

15 (b) If abandoned property in Baltimore City **CONSISTING OF EITHER A VACANT**
16 **LOT OR IMPROVED PROPERTY CITED AS VACANT AND UNFIT FOR HUMAN**
17 **HABITATION ON A HOUSING OR BUILDING VIOLATION NOTICE** sold under [§ 14–817(c)
18 of] this subtitle [with a minimum bid less than the lien amount] is subject to a ground rent
19 or lease for a term of 99 years renewable forever, the collector shall sell the whole fee simple
20 interest in the property.
