#### A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

### 2 Commission to Study Legislative and Congressional Districting

3 FOR the purpose of establishing the Commission to Study Legislative and Congressional Districting; providing for the composition, chair, and staffing of the Commission; 4  $\mathbf{5}$ prohibiting a member of the Commission from receiving certain compensation, but 6 authorizing the reimbursement of certain expenses; requiring the Commission to 7 study and make recommendations regarding legislative and congressional 8 districting; requiring the Commission to report its findings and recommendations to 9 the Governor, the President of the Senate, the Speaker of the House of Delegates, and the chairs of certain committees of the General Assembly on or before a certain 10 date; providing for the termination of this Act; and generally relating to the 11 12Commission to Study Legislative and Congressional Districting.

# 13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, 14 That:

- 15 (a) There is a Commission to Study Legislative and Congressional Districting.
- 16 (b) The Commission consists of the following members:
- 17 (1) two members of the Senate of Maryland, appointed by the President of 18 the Senate, one of whom the President of the Senate shall appoint as a cochair of the 19 Commission;
- 20 (2) two members of the House of Delegates, appointed by the Speaker of 21 the House, one of whom the Speaker of the House shall appoint as a cochair of the 22 Commission;
- 23 (3) the Secretary of Planning, or the Secretary's designee;
- 24 (4) the Attorney General, or the Attorney General's designee;

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the State Administrator of Elections, or the State Administrator's 1 (5) $\mathbf{2}$ designee: and 3 (6)a representative of the Maryland League of Women Voters, appointed by the Governor, from a list submitted by the Maryland League of Women Voters. 4 The Department of Legislative Services shall provide staff for the  $\mathbf{5}$ (c) 6 Commission. 7 A member of the Commission: (d) 8 (1)may not receive compensation as a member of the Commission; but 9 is entitled to reimbursement for expenses under the Standard State (2)Travel Regulations, as provided in the State budget. 10 11 (e) The Commission shall: 12(1)study the State's legislative and congressional redistricting processes; 13 and 14 (2)make recommendations regarding: criteria that should be used to draw legislative and congressional 15(i) districts and how each criterion should be weighed; 16 17(ii) the entity that should draw the legislative and congressional 18district maps; 19 (iii) ways to make the legislative and congressional districting 20processes nonpartisan; and 21ways to partner with other states to make congressional (iv) 22districting nonpartisan throughout the country. 23(f) On or before December 31, 2016, the Commission shall report its findings and 24recommendations to the Governor and, in accordance with § 2-1246 of the State Government Article, the President of the Senate, the Speaker of the House of Delegates, 2526the Chair of the Education, Health, and Environmental Affairs Committee, and the Chair 27of the Committee on Ways and Means.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 2016. It shall remain effective for a period of 1 year and, at the end of June 30, 2017, with no further action required by the General Assembly, this Act shall be abrogated and of no further force and effect.

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
