17 (g) (1) Except as provided in paragraphs (2) and (3) of this subsection, a 18 person, other than the owner or occupant, while hunting for any wild bird or mammal may 19 not shoot or discharge any firearm or other deadly weapon within 150 yards, known as the 20 "safety zone", of a dwelling house, residence, church, or other building or camp occupied by

human beings, or shoot at any wild bird or mammal while it is within this area, withoutthe specific advance permission of the owner or occupant.

3 (2) A person, while hunting for any wild bird or mammal, may not shoot or 4 discharge any firearm within 300 yards of a public or nonpublic school during school hours 5 or at a time when a school-approved activity is taking place.

6 (3) (i) For archery hunters in Carroll County [or], Frederick County, 7 OR HARFORD COUNTY, the safety zone described in paragraph (1) of this subsection 8 extends for 50 yards from a dwelling house, residence, church, or any other building or 9 camp occupied by human beings.

(ii) For archery hunters in [Harford County or] Montgomery County,
the safety zone described in paragraph (1) of this subsection extends for 100 yards from a
dwelling house, residence, church, or any other building or camp occupied by human beings.

13 (4) During any open hunting season, a person, other than the owner or 14 occupant, may not hunt or chase willfully any wild bird or mammal within the safety zone 15 without the specific advance permission of the owner or occupant.

16 (5) IN HARFORD COUNTY, AN ARCHERY HUNTER SHALL USE A TREE 17 STAND WHEN HUNTING ANY WILD BIRD OR MAMMAL WITHIN 50 TO 100 YARDS OF A 18 DWELLING HOUSE, RESIDENCE, CHURCH, PUBLIC OR NONPUBLIC SCHOOL, OR 19 OTHER BUILDING OR CAMP OCCUPIED BY HUMAN BEINGS.

20 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 21 1, 2016.
