## CHAPTER \_\_\_\_\_

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Allegany County – Alcoholic Beverages – Minimum Age to Serve Liquor**

3 FOR the purpose of altering in Allegany County the minimum age for an individual to serve  
4 liquor; and generally relating to alcoholic beverages in Allegany County.

5 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,

6 Article – Alcoholic Beverages

9 (As enacted by Chapter \_\_\_\_ (S.B. \_\_\_\_)(6lr1406) of the Acts of the General Assembly  
10 of 2016)

11 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,  
12 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

13 **Article – Alcoholic Beverages**

14 9–1902.

15 (a) A license holder may employ an individual between the ages of 18 and 21  
16 years.

17 (b) To be allowed to sell or serve beer [and], light wine, **AND LIQUOR**, an  
18 individual shall be at least 18 years old.
