1 AN ACT concerning

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Public Health - Copies of Medical Records - Fees

FOR the purpose of <u>altering a certain provision of law to authorize health care providers to require certain persons to pay a cost-based fee for providing certain information, rather than the reasonable cost; altering the fees health care providers and hospitals may charge for copying and mailing certain medical records and for retrieving and preparing certain medical records; authorizing certain hospitals and other health care providers to charge a certain fee fees and a certain costs cost for electronic copies of medical records that are in an electronic format requested by certain persons, subject to certain limitations; repealing a certain provision of law that allowed for fees charged for copies of medical records to be adjusted annually for inflation in accordance with the Consumer Price Index; providing that certain fees may not be adjusted annually for inflation in accordance with the Consumer Price Index; making conforming changes; and generally relating to fees for copies of medical records.</u>

5 6 7 8 9	{ (7) } (6) Notwithstanding any other provision of law, any person or entity who is not subject to the provisions of this subsection and who obtains a medical record from a health care provider or the provider's agent may not charge a fee for any subsequent copies of that medical record that exceeds the fee authorized under paragraph (3)(i) of this subsection.
