- 7 (c) A local jurisdiction may charge fees necessary to cover the cost of 8 implementation and enforcement of the Standards and any local amendments to the 9 Standards.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 11 October 1, 2016.
