16 17 18	EACH LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCY IN THE STATE SHALL ADOPT A WRITTEN POLICY ESTABLISHING PROCEDURES FOR HOMICIDE INVESTIGATIONS, INCLUDING REQUIREMENTS THAT:
19 20	(1) THE SCENE OF A HOMICIDE BE PROTECTED FROM OUTSIDE DISTURBANCE UNTIL THE INVESTIGATION IS COMPLETE;
