- 13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
- 14 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
- 15 Article Public Utilities
- 16 **7–305.1**.
- 17 (A) (1) IN THIS SECTION THE FOLLOWING WORDS HAVE THE MEANINGS
- 18 INDICATED.
- 19 (2) "CARBON FOOTPRINT" MEANS THE AMOUNT OF CARBON DIOXIDE
- 20 AND OTHER CARBON COMPOUNDS EMITTED DUE TO THE PRODUCTION AND
- 21 CONSUMPTION OF ENERGY BY A CUSTOMER OF A UTILITY COMPANY.
- 22 (3) "CUSTOMER" MEANS A RETAIL CUSTOMER OF A UTILITY
- 23 COMPANY.



- 1 (4) "UTILITY COMPANY" MEANS A GAS COMPANY, AN ELECTRIC COMPANY, OR A GAS AND ELECTRIC COMPANY.
- 3 (B) THE COMMISSION SHALL DEVELOP A METHODOLOGY TO CALCULATE 4 THE CARBON FOOTPRINT FOR EACH CUSTOMER.
- 5 (C) A UTILITY COMPANY SHALL:
- 6 (1) CALCULATE THE CARBON FOOTPRINT FOR EACH OF THE UTILITY 7 COMPANY'S CUSTOMERS; AND
- 8 (2) INCLUDE THE CUSTOMER'S CARBON FOOTPRINT IN THE 9 CUSTOMER'S MONTHLY BILL.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2016.
