12(I) ATTENDED A PUBLIC OR NONPUBLIC SECONDARY SCHOOL13IN THE STATE FOR AT LEAST 3 YEARS;

(IV) IN THE CASE OF AN APPLICANT WHO IS NOT A PERMANENT
 RESIDENT, PROVIDES AN AFFIDAVIT STATING THAT THE APPLICANT WILL FILE AN
 APPLICATION TO BECOME A PERMANENT RESIDENT WITHIN 30 DAYS AFTER THE
 APPLICANT BECOMES ELIGIBLE TO DO SO; AND

(V) IN THE CASE OF AN APPLICANT WHO IS REQUIRED TO
REGISTER WITH THE SELECTIVE SERVICE SYSTEM, PROVIDES DOCUMENTATION
THAT THE APPLICANT HAS COMPLIED WITH THE REGISTRATION REQUIREMENT.

29 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 30 October 1, 2016.
