CHAPTER _____

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Public Schools – Food Recovery Programs – Authorization**

3 FOR the purpose of authorizing a county board of education to develop and implement a
4 certain food recovery program for schools under the jurisdiction of the county board;
5 authorizing a county board, if it exercises certain authority, to apply for recognition
6 of its food recovery program under any food recovery certification program; defining
7 a certain term; and generally relating to food recovery in public schools.

13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,

14 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

15 **Article – Education**

16 **4–132.**

1 (A) IN THIS SECTION, "FOOD RECOVERY" MEANS THE REDUCTION OF FOOD
2 WASTE THROUGH THE DONATION OF LEFTOVER OR EXCESS FOOD TO A LOCAL FOOD
3 BANK OR ANY OTHER NONPROFIT ORGANIZATION.

4 (B) A COUNTY BOARD MAY DEVELOP AND IMPLEMENT A FOOD RECOVERY
5 PROGRAM FOR SCHOOLS UNDER THE JURISDICTION OF THE COUNTY BOARD.

6 (C) IF A COUNTY BOARD EXERCISES THE AUTHORITY GRANTED IN
7 SUBSECTION (B) OF THIS SECTION, THE COUNTY BOARD MAY APPLY FOR
8 RECOGNITION OF ITS FOOD RECOVERY PROGRAM UNDER ANY FOOD RECOVERY
9 CERTIFICATION PROGRAM.

10 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July
11 1, 2016.
