FOR the purpose of authorizing a county board of education to develop and implement a certain food recovery program for schools under the jurisdiction of the county board; authorizing a county board, if it exercises certain authority, to apply for recognition

of its food recovery program under any food recovery certification program; defining

(A) IN THIS SECTION, "FOOD RECOVERY" MEANS THE REDUCTION OF F WASTE THROUGH THE DONATION OF LEFTOVER OR EXCESS FOOD TO A LOCAL F

(B) A COUNTY BOARD MAY DEVELOP AND IMPLEMENT A FOOD RECOVER.
