CHAPTER

1 AN ACT concerning

2 Allegany County - Alcoholic Beverages - Sunday Sales for Class A Licenses

3 FOR the purpose of authorizing a holder of a Class A beer license, a Class A beer and light wine license, or a Class A beer, wine, and liquor license to sell certain alcoholic 4 5 beverages during certain hours under certain circumstances in Allegany County; 6 authorizing the Board of License Commissioners for Allegany County to issue a 7 certain Sunday sales permit to holders of certain licenses under certain 8 circumstances; specifying that an applicant for a certain Sunday sales permit need 9 not have certain kitchen facilities on the licensed premises; providing that a certain 10 Sunday sales permit authorizes the holder to sell certain alcoholic beverages for 11 off-premises consumption during certain hours on not more than a certain number 12 of Sundays in a year; specifying the fee for each time a certain Sunday sales permit 13 is used; and generally relating to alcoholic beverages in Allegany County.


