## A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Frederick County – Alcoholic Beverages – Refillable Container Permits**

3 FOR the purpose of authorizing the Board of License Commissioners for Frederick County  
4 to issue a refillable container permit for draft beer and for wine to a holder of a Class  
5 A alcoholic beverages license or a Class B alcoholic beverages license; providing for  
6 certain permit fees; and generally relating to alcoholic beverages in Frederick  
7 County.

23 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,

24 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

4 (a) The following sections of Title 4, Subtitle 11 (“Additional License Privileges”)  
5 of Division I of this article apply in the County without exception or variation:

6 (1) § 4-1102 (“Corkage — Consuming wine not purchased from license  
7 holder on licensed premises”); and

8 (2) § 4-1103 (“Removal of partially consumed bottle of wine from licensed  
9 premises”).

10 (b) The following sections of Title 4, Subtitle 11 (“Additional License Privileges”)  
11 of Division I of this article [do not] apply in the County:

12 (1) § 4-1104 (“Refillable container permit — Draft beer”), **SUBJECT TO §**  
13 **20-1104 OF THIS SUBTITLE**; and

14 (2) § 4-1104 (“Refillable container permit — Wine”), **SUBJECT TO §**  
15 **20-1105 OF THIS SUBTITLE**.
