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## CHAPTER \_\_\_\_\_

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Harford County – Alcoholic Beverages – Community College License**

3 FOR the purpose of establishing a Class CC (community college) beer and wine license in  
4 Harford County; authorizing the Board of License Commissioners to issue the license  
5 to ~~an officer~~ officers of a community college for use on certain parts of the community  
6 college campus; providing that the license authorizes the sale of beer and wine for  
7 on-premises consumption to individuals who attend certain public events and to  
8 members of certain groups and their guests who attend events held for those groups;  
9 prohibiting a license holder from selling beer and wine at certain events; limiting the  
10 number of days per year the license holder may sell beer and wine at certain events;  
11 prohibiting a license holder from allowing alcoholic beverages to be consumed during  
12 a certain time; prohibiting, with a certain exception, a license holder from allowing  
13 an individual to carry alcoholic beverages onto or from the licensed premises;  
14 providing for an annual license fee; and generally relating to alcoholic beverages  
15 licenses in Harford County.

5 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,  
 6 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

7 **Article – Alcoholic Beverages**

8 22–102.

9 This title applies only in Harford County.

10 **22–807.1.**

11 (A) THERE IS A CLASS CC (COMMUNITY COLLEGE) BEER AND WINE  
 12 LICENSE.

13 (B) THE BOARD MAY ISSUE THE LICENSE TO ~~AN OFFICER~~ OFFICERS OF A  
 14 COMMUNITY COLLEGE FOR USE ON ENCLOSED PARTS OF THE COMMUNITY COLLEGE  
 15 CAMPUS THAT ARE:

16 (1) OWNED BY THE COMMUNITY COLLEGE; AND

17 (2) USED AND EQUIPPED BY THE COMMUNITY COLLEGE TO PROMOTE  
 18 OR HOST EVENTS, INCLUDING ARTISTIC, CULTURAL, OR CIVIC EXHIBITS, MEETINGS,  
 19 FESTIVALS, SHOWS, OR OTHER ENTERTAINMENT PRODUCTIONS.

20 (C) THE LICENSE AUTHORIZES THE LICENSE HOLDER TO SELL BEER AND  
 21 WINE, AT RETAIL, AT THE PLACE DESCRIBED IN THE LICENSE, FOR ON–PREMISES  
 22 CONSUMPTION TO:

23 (1) INDIVIDUALS WHO ATTEND AN EVENT THAT IS OPEN TO THE  
 24 PUBLIC; AND

25 (2) MEMBERS OF A CLUB, A SOCIETY, OR AN ASSOCIATION AND THEIR  
 26 GUESTS WHO ATTEND AN EVENT THAT IS HELD FOR THAT GROUP.

27 (D) (1) THE LICENSE HOLDER MAY NOT SELL BEER AND WINE ON THE  
 28 COMMUNITY COLLEGE CAMPUS AT:

29 ~~(1)~~ (I) A STUDENT SPORTING EVENT; OR

30 ~~(2)~~ (II) AN EVENT THAT IS SPONSORED BY STUDENTS.

1           **(2) THE LICENSE HOLDER MAY SELL BEER AND WINE AT EVENTS**  
2 **THAT ARE HELD ON THE COMMUNITY COLLEGE CAMPUS FOR A MAXIMUM OF 25 DAYS**  
3 **PER YEAR.**

4           **(E) AFTER AN EVENT IS OVER, THE LICENSE HOLDER MAY NOT ALLOW**  
5 **ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES TO BE CONSUMED ON THE LICENSED PREMISES FROM**  
6 **MIDNIGHT TO NOON THE FOLLOWING DAY.**

7           **(F) A LICENSE HOLDER MAY NOT ALLOW AN INDIVIDUAL TO CARRY**  
8 **ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES ONTO OR FROM THE LICENSED PREMISES, EXCEPT A**  
9 **WHOLESALE OF BEER OR WINE WHO CONDUCTS BUSINESS REGARDING AN EVENT**  
10 **FOR WHICH A LICENSE HAS BEEN ISSUED UNDER THIS SECTION.**

11           **(G) THE ANNUAL LICENSE FEE IS \$1,500.**

12           SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July  
13 1, 2016.
