A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Prince George's County – Emergency Medical Services – Motorcycle Unit**

3 **PG 312–16**

4 FOR the purpose of requiring the governing body of Prince George's County, by local law,
5 to establish an emergency medical response unit that travels by motorcycle to assist
6 with emergencies in Prince George's County; providing that the local law shall
7 require a member of a certain unit to possess certain licenses or certifications;
8 defining a certain term; and generally relating to emergency medical services
9 providers in Prince George's County.

15 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
16 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

17 **Article – Public Safety**

18 **7–404.**

19 (A) IN THIS SECTION, “EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES PROVIDER” HAS
20 THE MEANING STATED IN § 13–516 OF THE EDUCATION ARTICLE.

21 (B) (1) THE GOVERNING BODY OF PRINCE GEORGE'S COUNTY, BY LOCAL
22 LAW, SHALL ESTABLISH AN EMERGENCY MEDICAL RESPONSE UNIT THAT TRAVELS
23 BY MOTORCYCLE TO ASSIST WITH EMERGENCIES IN PRINCE GEORGE'S COUNTY.

1 **(2) THE LOCAL LAW SHALL REQUIRE A MEMBER OF THE UNIT TO:**

2 **(I) BE LICENSED OR CERTIFIED AS AN EMERGENCY MEDICAL**
3 **SERVICES PROVIDER BY THE STATE EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES BOARD; AND**

4 **(II) BE LICENSED TO DRIVE A MOTORCYCLE.**

5 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
6 October 1, 2016.
