## A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **General Assembly – Limitation on Introduction of Bills**

3 FOR the purpose of prohibiting members of the General Assembly from introducing more  
4 than a certain number of bills during a regular or special legislative session;  
5 providing that this Act does not apply to bills introduced on behalf of certain persons  
6 or bills prefiled under a certain provision of law; and generally relating to the  
7 introduction of bills in the General Assembly.

13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,  
14 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

15 **Article – State Government**

16 **2–1502.1.**

17 **(A) THIS SECTION DOES NOT APPLY TO:**

18 **(1) BILLS INTRODUCED ON BEHALF OF A LOCAL GOVERNMENT OR A**  
19 **LOCAL GOVERNMENT ENTITY, AN EXECUTIVE DEPARTMENT OR OTHER UNIT OF THE**  
20 **EXECUTIVE BRANCH, OR THE OFFICE OF THE GOVERNOR; OR**

21 **(2) BILLS PREFILED UNDER § 2–1502 OF THIS SUBTITLE.**

1           **(B) A MEMBER OF THE SENATE MAY NOT INTRODUCE MORE THAN 15 BILLS**  
2 **DURING A REGULAR OR SPECIAL LEGISLATIVE SESSION.**

3           **(C) A MEMBER OF THE HOUSE OF DELEGATES MAY NOT INTRODUCE MORE**  
4 **THAN 10 BILLS DURING A REGULAR OR SPECIAL LEGISLATIVE SESSION.**

5           SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect  
6 October 1, 2016.
