- 22 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND.
- 23 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

24 Article – Education

- 26 (a) (1) The Mayor and City Council of Baltimore shall be governed by the 27 requirements and regulations pertaining to the Enoch Pratt Free Library of Baltimore City 28 as provided in Chapter 181 of the Acts of 1882 and any other laws applicable to the 29 operation of public libraries.
- 30 (2) The powers and duties of the Board of Trustees of the Enoch Pratt Free 31 Library are as provided in Chapter 181 of the Acts of 1882 and the Charter and the Articles 32 of Incorporation of the Enoch Pratt Free Library and other laws applicable to the Board of 33 Trustees of the Enoch Pratt Free Library.
- 34 (3) EACH BRANCH A STATE GRANT SHALL BE MADE AVAILABLE TO
 35 FUND THE INCREASED OPERATING EXPENSES FOR THE BRANCHES OF THE ENOCH
 36 PRATT FREE LIBRARY SHALL THAT ARE REQUIRED TO BE OPEN TO THE PUBLIC 7
 37 DAYS A WEEK FROM 9 A.M. TO 9 P.M., EXCLUDING HOLIDAYS INCREASE THEIR

- AS PROVIDED IN THE STATE BUDGET, BEGINNING WITH 1 **(4)** (I)2 FISCAL YEAR 2018 FOR FISCAL YEAR 2018 AND EACH FISCAL YEAR THEREAFTER 3 THROUGH FISCAL YEAR 2022, THE STATE SHALL REMIT TO BALTIMORE CITY EACH YEAR AN AMOUNT EQUAL TO 80% OF THE ADDITIONAL OPERATING EXPENSES 4 RELATED TO GOVERNOR SHALL INCLUDE IN THE STATE OPERATING BUDGET 5 \$3,000,000 IN GENERAL FUNDS TO SUPPORT THE ADDITIONAL OPERATING 6 7 EXPENSES FOR THE INCREASED HOURS OF OPERATION OF ALL THE BRANCHES OF 8 THE ENOCH PRATT FREE LIBRARY THAT, IN THAT FISCAL YEAR, WILL BE SUBJECT TO INCREASED OPERATING HOURS AS PROVIDED IN PARAGRAPH (3) OF THIS 9

- 11 (II) 1. FOR FISCAL YEAR 2018 AND EACH FISCAL YEAR
 12 THEREAFTER, IN ORDER TO ACCESS THE STATE GRANT, TO RECEIVE ANY STATE
 13 FUNDS UNDER SUBPARAGRAPH (I) OF THIS PARAGRAPH, BALTIMORE CITY SHALL

- 27 <u>2. The Department shall establish a process to</u> 28 Distribute the State grant to Baltimore City or the Enoch Pratt Free 29 <u>Library for the Additional operating expenses related to the increased</u> 30 Hours of operation.
- 31 <u>SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the Enoch Pratt Free Library</u> 32 <u>System and the State Department of Education shall:</u>
- 33 <u>(1) conduct a needs assessment and make recommendations regarding</u>
 34 <u>which branches of the Enoch Pratt Free Library would benefit the most from increased</u>
 35 <u>operating hours, with branches in low-income neighborhoods to be given priority</u>
 36 <u>consideration in any recommendations; and</u>

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1 (2) on or before December 31, 2016, report their findings and
2 recommendations, in accordance with § 2-1246 of the State Government Article, to the
3 Senate Budget and Taxation Committee and the House Appropriations Committee.

SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the remittance of State funds to Baltimore City for fiscal year 2018, as required under Section 1 of this Act, is contingent on the submission of the findings and recommendations to the Senate Budget and Taxation Committee and the House Appropriations Committee, as required under Section 2 of this Act.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That:

- 10 (a) It is the intent of the General Assembly that the increased operating hours of
 11 the Enoch Pratt Free Library as provided in this Act shall be prioritized to the library
 12 branches that are located in poor and underserved communities.
- 13 (b) On or before June 1, 2017, and on or before each June 1 through 2022, the
 14 Mayor and City Council of Baltimore City shall provide an annual report to the Department
 15 of Budget and Management and, in accordance with § 2–1246 of the State Government
 16 Article, the Senate Budget and Taxation Committee and the House Appropriations
 17 Committee that includes:
- 18 (1) a list of the branches of the Enoch Pratt Free Library in the next fiscal 19 year that will be subject to increased operating hours above the operating schedule in place 20 as of January 1, 2016; and
- 21 <u>(2) an explanation of the selection process for the branches of the Enoch</u> 22 <u>Pratt Free Library that will be subject to increased operating hours in the next fiscal year.</u>
- 23 <u>SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That, on or before December 31,</u>
 24 <u>2020, the State Department of Education shall submit a report to the Department of Budget</u>
 25 <u>and Management and, in accordance with § 2–1246 of the State Government Article, the</u>
 26 <u>Senate Budget and Taxation Committee and the House Appropriations Committee that:</u>
- 27 (1) includes an evaluation of the impact of the increased hours of operation 28 of the branches of the Enoch Pratt Free Library;
- 29 (2) <u>discusses the appropriateness of continued increased State funding for</u> 30 <u>increased hours of operation of branches of the Enoch Pratt Free Library above the hours of</u> 31 <u>operation in effect as of January 1, 2016; and</u>
- 32 (3) includes recommendations for the future of continued increased State 33 funding for the Enoch Pratt Free Library, including new technologies and changing 34 neighborhood demographics and characteristics.
- SECTION $\frac{2}{2}$. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2016.
