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- 1 (2) "PERCENTAGE PREFERENCE" MEANS THE PERCENT OF THE
 2 LOWEST RESPONSIVE BID OR OFFER SUBMITTED BY A RESPONSIBLE BIDDER OR
 3 OFFEROR FROM THE STATE BUT THAT IS NOT A RESIDENT BIDDER OR OFFEROR
 4 FROM THE CITY OF BALTIMORE BY WHICH A RESPONSIVE BID OR OFFER BY A
 5 RESIDENT BIDDER OR OFFEROR FROM THE CITY OF BALTIMORE MAY:
- 6 (I) EXCEED THE LOWEST BID OR OFFER; AND
- 7 (II) BE AWARDED A PROCUREMENT CONTRACT FOR GOODS OR 8 SERVICES.
- 9 (3) "RESIDENT BIDDER OR OFFEROR FROM THE CITY OF BALTIMORE" MEANS A BIDDER OR AN OFFEROR WHOSE PRINCIPAL OFFICE OR 11 OPERATION IS LOCATED IN THE CITY OF BALTIMORE.
- 12 (4) "RESPONSIBLE BIDDER OR OFFEROR FROM THE STATE BUT THAT
 13 IS NOT A RESIDENT BIDDER OR OFFEROR FROM THE CITY OF BALTIMORE" MEANS A
 14 BIDDER OR AN OFFEROR WHOSE PRINCIPAL OFFICE OR OPERATION IS IN THE STATE
 15 IN A JURISDICTION OTHER THAN THE CITY OF BALTIMORE.

- 20 (B) THIS SECTION APPLIES TO THE PROCUREMENT OF GOODS AND SERVICES BY ANY PUBLIC INSTITUTION OF HIGHER EDUCATION LOCATED IN THE CITY OF BALTIMORE IN WHICH RESPONSIVE BIDS OR OFFERS ARE SUBMITTED ONLY BY BIDDERS OR OFFERORS WHOSE PRINCIPAL OFFICE OR OPERATION IS LOCATED IN THE STATE.
- 25 (C) WHEN A PUBLIC INSTITUTION OF HIGHER EDUCATION LOCATED IN THE 26 CITY OF BALTIMORE PROCURES GOODS OR SERVICES, THE INSTITUTION SHALL 27 GIVE A PERCENTAGE PREFERENCE OF 5% TO THE RESIDENT BIDDER OR OFFEROR 28 FROM THE CITY OF BALTIMORE THAT SUBMITS THE LOWEST RESPONSIVE BID OR 29 OFFER FROM AMONG THE RESPONSIBLE BIDDERS OR OFFERORS FROM THE STATE 30 IF:

 2 IS NOT A RESIDENT BIDDER OR OFFEROR FROM THE CITY OF BALTIMORE SUBMITS
 3 THE LOWEST RESPONSIVE BID OR OFFER; AND
- 4 (3) A PREFERENCE DOES NOT CONFLICT WITH A FEDERAL LAW OR 5 GRANT AFFECTING THE PROCUREMENT CONTRACT.
- 6 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 7 October 1, 2016.
