# SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

### Article – Transportation

13 17–104.1.

14 **(A)** The operator of a moped or motor scooter shall carry evidence of the required 15 security when operating the moped or motor scooter.

#### 16 **(B) ANY PERSON WHO IS CONVICTED OF A VIOLATION OF THIS SECTION IS** 17 **SUBJECT TO A FINE NOT EXCEEDING \$50.**

18 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 19 October 1, 2016.
