4 FOR the purpose of amending the Maryland Consolidated Capital Bond Loan of 2015 to
5 add a grantee to certain grants; amending the Maryland Consolidated Capital Bond
6 Loan of 2016 to repeal the matching fund requirement for a certain grant; making
7 this Act an emergency measure; providing for the effective date of certain provisions
8 of this Act; and generally relating to amending the Maryland Consolidated Capital
9 Bond ~~Loan~~ Loans of ~~2015~~ 2015 and 2016.

33 (AE) Maryland Hall for the Creative Arts. Provide a grant to the Board of
34 Directors of the Maryland Hall for the Creative Arts, Inc. for the
35 planning, design, construction, repair, renovation, reconstruction,
36 and capital equipping of the Maryland Hall for the Creative Arts,
37 located in Anne Arundel County [, subject to the requirement that the
38 grantee provide an equal and matching fund for this purpose] (Anne

1 Arundel County)..... 750,000

2 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That Section 2 of this Act shall take
3 effect June 1, 2016.

4 SECTION ~~2~~ 4. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act is an emergency
5 measure, is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health or safety, has
6 been passed by a yea and nay vote supported by three-fifths of all the members elected to
7 each of the two Houses of the General Assembly, and, except as provided in Section 3 of
8 this Act, shall take effect from the date it is enacted.
