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## A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Residential Service Agencies – Third Party Payor Reimbursement – Entitlement**

3 FOR the purpose of altering a certain provision of law to provide that licensure under  
4 certain provisions of law entitles a residential service agency to reimbursement by a  
5 third party payor; and generally relating to the reimbursement of residential service  
6 agencies by third party payors.

12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,  
13 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

14 **Article – Health – General**

15 19–4A–10.

16 [Except as provided by federal law, licensure] **LICENSURE** under this subtitle [does  
17 not entitle] **ENTITLES** a residential service agency to reimbursement by a third party  
18 payor.

19 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect  
20 October 1, 2016.
