A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Crimes – Solicitation to Commit Murder or Arson – Statute of Limitations**

3 FOR the purpose of providing that the statute of limitations for the crime of solicitation to
4 commit murder in the first degree, murder in the second degree, arson in the first
5 degree, or arson in the second degree is the statute of limitations for the prosecution
6 of the substantive crime that is the subject of the solicitation; and generally relating
7 to the statute of limitations for the crime of solicitation.

13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
14 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

17 **(FF) THE STATUTE OF LIMITATIONS FOR THE PROSECUTION OF THE CRIME**
18 **OF SOLICITATION TO COMMIT MURDER IN THE FIRST DEGREE IN VIOLATION OF §**
19 **2–201 OF THE CRIMINAL LAW ARTICLE, MURDER IN THE SECOND DEGREE IN**
20 **VIOLATION OF § 2–204 OF THE CRIMINAL LAW ARTICLE, ARSON IN THE FIRST**
21 **DEGREE IN VIOLATION OF § 6–102 OF THE CRIMINAL LAW ARTICLE, OR ARSON IN**
22 **THE SECOND DEGREE IN VIOLATION OF § 6–103 OF THE CRIMINAL LAW ARTICLE IS**
23 **THE STATUTE OF LIMITATIONS FOR THE PROSECUTION OF THE SUBSTANTIVE CRIME**
24 **THAT IS THE SUBJECT OF THE SOLICITATION.**
