A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Maryland Medical Assistance Program – Former Foster Care**
3 **Adolescents – Dental Care**

4 FOR the purpose of requiring the Maryland Medical Assistance Program, subject to the
5 limitations of the State budget, and as permitted by federal law, to provide dental
6 care for certain former foster care adolescents; and generally relating to dental care
7 services provided by the Maryland Medical Assistance Program to former foster care
8 adolescents.

19 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
20 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

21 **Article – Health – General**

22 15–103.

23 (a) (1) The Secretary shall administer the Maryland Medical Assistance
24 Program.

1 (2) The Program:

2 (x) Subject to the limitations of the State budget, and as permitted
3 by federal law:

4 1. Shall provide comprehensive medical care, **DENTAL**
5 **CARE**, and other health care services for former foster care adolescents who, on their 18th
6 birthday, were in foster care under the responsibility of the State and are not otherwise
7 eligible for Program benefits; and

8 2. May provide comprehensive medical care and other health
9 care services for former foster care adolescents who, on their 18th birthday, were in foster
10 care under the responsibility of any other state or the District of Columbia;

11 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
12 October 1, 2016.
