30 A member is entitled to eligibility service that equals:

31 (1) the member's service credit transferred from a retirement or pension 32 system under Title 37 of this article;

1 (2) for a member who has transferred to the Employees' Pension System 2 from the Employees' Retirement System or to the Teachers' Pension System from the 3 Teachers' Retirement System, the member's creditable service recognized under the 4 previous system through the date before the member became a member of the current 5 system;
