1 (b) The Board may issue the license for use by a restaurant, motel, or hotel that 2 has a facility:

3 (1) for serving full-course meals at least twice daily; and

4 (2) with seating at tables for at least [50] **25** individuals, not including 5 seats at bars or counters.

6 (c) The license authorizes the license holder to sell beer, wine, and liquor at the 7 place described in the license for on-premises consumption.

8 (d) The annual license fee is \$1,000.

9 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 10 1, 2016.
