1 AN ACT concerning

Retail Business Owners – Automated Teller Machines – Notice of Skimming Device

4 FOR the purpose of requiring the owner of a retail business with an automated teller $\mathbf{5}$ machine located on the premises of the business who has knowledge of an illegal 6 skimming device installed on or near the automated teller machine to post a certain 7 notice in a certain manner and to keep the notice posted for a certain period of time notify the operator of the automated teller machine of the existence of a certain 8 9 skimming device and certain information to identify the automated teller machine 10 under certain circumstances; providing for the application of this Act; defining a 11 certain term; and generally relating to automated teller machines located on retail 12 business premises.

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1(A)IN THIS SECTION, "OPERATOR" HAS THE MEANING STATED IN § 1-4012OF THE FINANCIAL INSTITUTIONS ARTICLE.

3 (B) THIS SECTION DOES NOT APPLY TO THE OWNER OF A RETAIL BUSINESS
 4 THAT IS A BANK OR CREDIT UNION.

5 (C) IF THE OWNER OF A RETAIL BUSINESS WITH AN AUTOMATED TELLER 6 MACHINE LOCATED ON THE PREMISES OF THE WHERE THE RETAIL BUSINESS IS 7 OPERATED HAS KNOWLEDGE THAT THE AUTOMATED TELLER MACHINE HAS AN 8 ILLEGAL SKIMMING DEVICE INSTALLED ON OR NEAR IT, THE RETAIL BUSINESS 9 OWNER SHALL:

(1) POST IN A CONSPICUOUS PLACE ON OR NEAR THE AUTOMATED
 TELLER MACHINE A NOTICE THAT WARNS CUSTOMERS OF THE AUTOMATED TELLER
 MACHINE THAT IT HAS AN ILLEGAL SKIMMING DEVICE INSTALLED ON OR NEAR IT;
 AND

14 (2) KEEP THE NOTICE POSTED UNDER ITEM (1) OF THIS SECTION
 15 UNTIL THE ILLEGAL SKIMMING DEVICE IS REMOVED FROM THE AUTOMATED TELLER
 16 MACHINE BY THE APPROPRIATE ENTITY IMMEDIATELY NOTIFY THE OPERATOR OF
 17 THE AUTOMATED TELLER MACHINE ABOUT:

18 (1) THE EXISTENCE OF THE SKIMMING DEVICE; AND

19(2)THE LOCATION AND OTHER IDENTIFYING INFORMATION ABOUT20THE AUTOMATED TELLER MACHINE TO ASSIST THE OPERATOR IN IDENTIFYING THE21AFFECTED AUTOMATED TELLER MACHINE.

22 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 23 October 1, 2016.
