## A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Baltimore City – Demolition Program Funding**

3 FOR the purpose of establishing a Baltimore City Demolition Program; requiring the  
4 Stadium Authority to administer the Program in accordance with a certain  
5 memorandum of understanding; requiring the Governor to include certain  
6 appropriations in the annual budget for certain fiscal years; and generally relating  
7 to a Baltimore City Demolition Program.

13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,  
14 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

15 **Article – Economic Development**

16 **10–622.1.**

17 **(A) THERE IS A BALTIMORE CITY DEMOLITION PROGRAM.**

18 **(B) THE AUTHORITY SHALL ADMINISTER THE PROGRAM IN ACCORDANCE**  
19 **WITH A MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING WITH THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL**  
20 **OF BALTIMORE CITY, IN CONSULTATION WITH THE DEPARTMENT OF HOUSING AND**  
21 **COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT.**

22 **(C) (1) EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN PARAGRAPH (2) OF THIS SUBSECTION,**  
23 **EACH FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING WITH FISCAL YEAR 2017 THROUGH FISCAL YEAR**

1 **2021, THE GOVERNOR SHALL INCLUDE AT LEAST \$18,000,000 IN THE ANNUAL**  
2 **BUDGET BILL AS AN APPROPRIATION TO THE AUTHORITY FOR THE PURPOSE OF THE**  
3 **PROGRAM.**

4 **(2) IF LESS THAN \$18,000,000 IS APPROPRIATED FOR FISCAL YEAR**  
5 **2017 UNDER PARAGRAPH (1) OF THIS SUBSECTION, THE GOVERNOR SHALL**  
6 **APPROPRIATE IN FISCAL YEAR 2018, IN ADDITION TO THE AMOUNT REQUIRED FOR**  
7 **FISCAL YEAR 2018 UNDER PARAGRAPH (1) OF THIS SUBSECTION, \$18,000,000 LESS**  
8 **ANY AMOUNT APPROPRIATED FOR THIS PURPOSE IN FISCAL YEAR 2017.**

9 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July  
10 1, 2016.
