- SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

1 (C) A PERSON IS NOT CIVILLY LIABLE FOR ENTERING A PROPERTY OR FOR 2 ANY ACT NECESSARY TO ENTER A PROPERTY IN ORDER TO PROVIDE ASSISTANCE OR 3 MEDICAL CARE IF:

- (1) THE ACT IS NOT ONE OF GROSS NEGLIGENCE; AND

5 (2) THE PERSON IS RESPONDING TO A 9–1–1 CALL FOR EMERGENCY 6 ASSISTANCE.

7 [(c)] (D) An individual who is not covered otherwise by this section is not civilly 8 liable for any act or omission in providing assistance or medical aid to a victim at the scene 9 of an emergency, if:

10 (1) The assistance or aid is provided in a reasonably prudent manner;

11 (2) The assistance or aid is provided without fee or other compensation; 12 and

13 (3) The individual relinquishes care of the victim when someone who is 14 licensed or certified by this State to provide medical care or services becomes available to 15 take responsibility.
