1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Education – Public High Schools – Agriculture Science**

3 FOR the purpose of ~~requiring~~ encouraging each county board of education, beginning in a
4 certain school year, to implement a certain agriculture science curriculum in a
5 certain number of public high schools in each county or a certain number of career
6 and technology education centers in each county; requiring that the agriculture
7 science curriculum be selected from existing curricula developed by the State
8 Department of Education or be developed by a county board and approved by the
9 Department; and generally relating to the implementation of an agriculture science
10 curriculum in each county.

16 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
17 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

3 SPECIFIED IN SUBSECTION (B) OF THIS SECTION IN:

4 (1) AT LEAST ONE PUBLIC HIGH SCHOOL IN THE COUNTY; OR

5 (2) AT LEAST ONE CAREER AND TECHNOLOGY EDUCATION CENTER IN
6 THE COUNTY.

7 (B) THE AGRICULTURE SCIENCE CURRICULUM IMPLEMENTED UNDER
8 SUBSECTION (A) OF THIS SECTION SHALL BE:

9 (1) SELECTED FROM EXISTING CURRICULA THAT ~~HAS~~ HAVE BEEN
10 DEVELOPED BY THE DEPARTMENT; OR

11 (2) DEVELOPED BY A COUNTY BOARD AND APPROVED BY THE
12 DEPARTMENT.

13 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
14 October 1, 2016.
