4 FOR the purpose of altering the date by which the Task Force to Study the Implementation
5 of a Dyslexia Education Program is required to submit certain findings and
6 recommendations; extending the termination date of the Task Force; and generally
7 relating to the Task Force to Study the Implementation of a Dyslexia Education
8 Program.

9 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,
10 Chapter 411 of the Acts of the General Assembly of 2015
11 Section 1(g) and 2

12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
13 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

14 **Chapter 411 of the Acts of 2015**

15 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
16 That:

17 (g) On or before December 30, ~~[2015]~~ **2016**, the Task Force shall report its
18 findings and recommendations to the Governor and, in accordance with § 2–1246 of the
19 State Government Article, the Senate Education, Health, and Environmental Affairs
20 Committee and the House Ways and Means Committee.

1 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect June
2 1, 2015. It shall remain effective for a period of [1 year] **2 YEARS** and 1 month and, at the
3 end of June 30, [2016] **2017**, with no further action required by the General Assembly, this
4 Act shall be abrogated and of no further force and effect.

5 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect June
6 1, 2016.
