1 AN ACT concerning

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Public Safety – Internet Crimes Against Children Task Force Fund – Establishment (Alicia's Law)

 $\mathbf{5}$ FOR the purpose of requiring that each fiscal year a certain portion of unclaimed lottery 6 prizes be distributed to the Internet Crimes Against Children Task Force Fund; 7 establishing the Internet Crimes Against Children Task Force Fund as a special, 8 nonlapsing fund; specifying the purpose of the Fund; requiring the Executive 9 Director of the Governor's Office of Crime Control and Prevention to administer the 10 Fund; requiring the State Treasurer to hold the Fund and the Comptroller, in 11 conjunction with the Executive Director, to account for the Fund; specifying the 12contents of the Fund; specifying the purpose for which the Fund may be used; 13 providing for the investment of money in and expenditures from the Fund; beginning 14 in a certain fiscal year, requiring the Governor to include in the annual budget bill 15an appropriation to the Fund; requiring the Executive Director to establish certain procedures for certain local law enforcement agencies to apply for certain grants; 16 17requiring a certain applicant to provide the Executive Director with certain 18 information; requiring that the Fund be distributed in a certain manner; requiring the Executive Director to make grants to local law enforcement agencies for certain 19 20purposes based on certain needs: requiring a local law enforcement agency that is 21awarded a grant to enter into a certain memorandum of understanding; requiring a 22local law enforcement agency to submit proof of certain grant expenditures to the Executive Director; exempting the Fund from a certain provision of law requiring 2324interest on State money in special funds to accrue to the General Fund of the State;

34 (A) IN THIS SUBTITLE THE FOLLOWING WORDS HAVE THE MEANINGS 35 INDICATED. 1 (B) "EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR" MEANS THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR OF THE 2 GOVERNOR'S OFFICE OF CRIME CONTROL AND PREVENTION.

3 (C) "FUND" MEANS THE INTERNET CRIMES AGAINST CHILDREN TASK 4 FORCE FUND.

5 (D) "LOCAL LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCY" MEANS AN AGENCY OF A COUNTY 6 OR MUNICIPAL CORPORATION IN THE STATE THAT PERFORMS POLICE PROTECTION 7 FUNCTIONS.

8 (E) "TASK FORCE" MEANS THE MARYLAND INTERNET CRIMES AGAINST 9 CHILDREN TASK FORCE ESTABLISHED BY THE DEPARTMENT OF STATE POLICE.

11 (A) THERE IS AN INTERNET CRIMES AGAINST CHILDREN TASK FORCE 12 FUND.

13 (B) THE PURPOSE OF THE FUND IS TO PROVIDE:

14(1)GRANTS TO LOCAL LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCIES FOR SALARIES,15TRAINING, AND EQUIPMENT TO BE USED FOR THE INVESTIGATION AND16PROSECUTION OF INTERNET CRIMES AGAINST CHILDREN; AND

17(2)FUNDING TO SUPPORT THE ONGOING OPERATIONS OF THE TASK18FORCE.

19 (C) THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR SHALL ADMINISTER THE FUND.

20 (D) (1) THE FUND IS A SPECIAL, NONLAPSING FUND THAT IS NOT 21 SUBJECT TO § 7–302 OF THE STATE FINANCE AND PROCUREMENT ARTICLE.

(2) THE STATE TREASURER SHALL HOLD THE FUND SEPARATELY
 AND THE COMPTROLLER SHALL ACCOUNT FOR THE FUND IN CONJUNCTION WITH
 THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR.

25 (E) THE FUND CONSISTS OF:

26 (1) REVENUE DISTRIBUTED TO THE FUND UNDER § 9–122 OF THE 27 STATE GOVERNMENT ARTICLE;

- 28 (2) MONEY APPROPRIATED IN THE STATE BUDGET TO THE FUND;
- 29 (3) (2) INTEREST EARNINGS OF THE FUND; AND

1 (4) (3) ANY OTHER MONEY FROM ANY OTHER SOURCE ACCEPTED 2 FOR THE BENEFIT OF THE FUND.

3 (F) THE FUND SHALL BE DISTRIBUTED <u>ON THE BASIS OF NEED, AS</u> 4 <u>DETERMINED BY THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR, IN THE FOLLOWING MANNER:</u>

5 (1) 40% of the money in the Fund for grants to local law 6 ENFORCEMENT AGENCIES FOR SALARIES, TRAINING, AND EQUIPMENT TO BE USED 7 FOR THE INVESTIGATION AND PROSECUTION OF INTERNET CRIMES AGAINST 8 CHILDREN; AND

9 (2) 60% OF THE MONEY IN THE FUND TO BE DISTRIBUTED TO THE 10 TASK FORCE TO SUPPORT THE ONGOING OPERATIONS OF THE TASK FORCE; AND

11(3)IN AN AMOUNT NOT GREATER THAN 25% OF THE FUND, TO CHILD12ADVOCACY CENTERS, AS ESTABLISHED UNDER § 11–923(H) OF THE CRIMINAL13PROCEDURE ARTICLE.

14(G)(1)THE STATE TREASURER SHALL INVEST THE MONEY OF THE FUND15IN THE SAME MANNER AS OTHER STATE MONEY MAY BE INVESTED.

16(2)ANY INTEREST EARNINGS OF THE FUND SHALL BE CREDITED TO17THE FUND.

18 (H) EXPENDITURES FROM THE FUND MAY BE MADE ONLY IN ACCORDANCE 19 WITH THE STATE BUDGET.

20(I)FOR FISCAL YEAR 2018 AND EACH FISCAL YEAR THEREAFTER, THE21GOVERNOR SHALL INCLUDE IN THE ANNUAL BUDGET BILL AN APPROPRIATION TO22THE FUND.

(1) (J) THE ACCOUNTS AND TRANSACTIONS OF THE FUND SHALL BE
 SUBJECT TO AUDIT BY THE LEGISLATIVE AUDITOR AS PROVIDED IN § 2–1220 OF THE
 STATE GOVERNMENT ARTICLE.

27(A)THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR SHALL ESTABLISH PROCEDURES FOR28LOCAL LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCIES TO APPLY FOR GRANTS FROM THE FUND.

(B) AN APPLICANT SHALL PROVIDE THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR WITH ANY
 INFORMATION THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR CONSIDERS NECESSARY TO MAKE
 GRANTS FOR SALARIES, TRAINING, AND EQUIPMENT TO BE USED FOR THE
 INVESTIGATION AND PROSECUTION OF INTERNET CRIMES AGAINST CHILDREN.

1(C)INACCORDANCE WITH THE STATE BUDGET, THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR2SHALL MAKE GRANTS TO LOCAL LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCIES FOR SALARIES,3TRAINING, AND EQUIPMENT TO BE USED FOR THE INVESTIGATION AND4PROSECUTION OF INTERNET CRIMES AGAINST CHILDREN BASED ON THE5COMPARATIVE NEEDS OF EACH LOCAL LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCY AS6DETERMINED FROM THE INFORMATION PROVIDED UNDER SUBSECTION (B) OF THIS7SECTION.

8 (D) (A) BEFORE THE DISTRIBUTION OF GRANT FUNDS, GRANT 9 **RECIPIENTS SHALL EXECUTE A MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING WITH THE TASK** FORCE AND AGREE TO WORK WITH THE TASK FORCE, ABIDING BY TASK FORCE 10 GUIDELINES AND PROTOCOLS RELATED TO THE INVESTIGATION AND PROSECUTION 11 OF INTERNET CRIMES AGAINST CHILDREN. 12

13(E) (B)AFTER RECEIVING A GRANT AWARD, THE LOCAL LAW14ENFORCEMENT AGENCY SHALL SUBMIT A REPORT DETAILING THE USE OF GRANT15EXPENDITURES TO THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR.
