# 2 Harford County – Alcoholic Beverages – Community College License

3 FOR the purpose of establishing a Class CC (community college) beer and wine license in 4 Harford County; authorizing the Board of License Commissioners to issue the license to <del>an officer</del> officers of a community college for use on certain parts of the community  $\mathbf{5}$ 6 college campus; providing that the license authorizes the sale of beer and wine for 7 on-premises consumption to individuals who attend certain public events and to 8 members of certain groups and their guests who attend events held for those groups; 9 prohibiting a license holder from selling beer and wine at certain events; *limiting the* number of days per year the license holder may sell beer and wine at certain events: 10 prohibiting a license holder from allowing alcoholic beverages to be consumed during 11 12a certain time; prohibiting, with a certain exception, a license holder from allowing 13 an individual to carry alcoholic beverages onto or from the licensed premises; 14providing for an annual license fee; and generally relating to alcoholic beverages 15licenses in Harford County.

(F) A LICENSE HOLDER MAY NOT ALLOW AN INDIVIDUAL TO CARRY
 ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES ONTO OR FROM THE LICENSED PREMISES, EXCEPT A
 WHOLESALER OF BEER OR WINE WHO CONDUCTS BUSINESS REGARDING AN EVENT
 FOR WHICH A LICENSE HAS BEEN ISSUED UNDER THIS SECTION.

17 (G) THE ANNUAL LICENSE FEE IS \$1,500.

18 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July1, 2016.
